HELPFUL PACKING TIPS

Please make sure that clothing brought to camp is appropriate for camp, and please label EVERYTHING brought to camp with camper's full name.

Three set of drawers – pack with your child (underwear, socks, shirts, shorts) so they know where it is. It can be used as their "nightstand" Put painters tape around it and label it with your camper's first and last name.

Duffel/trunk/suitcase with sheets, towels, flashlight, deck of cards, pillow, lovie, blanket, hanging clothes, folded longs and longs, etc – this way what goes on their nightstand can go on the drawers, what goes on their bed/towel rack can go there, shelf stuff can go on a shelf, hanging stuff can get hung, and extra stuff can go under or at the food of their bed.
