New: Camper Medication

New for summer 2025, All prescription medications must be packed in a **blister pack** with a copy of the prescription label (your pharmacy can print this for you).

- If camp is required to blister pack or otherwise organize your camper's medication on opening day, you will be charged a \$100 processing and handling fee.

The Campanion App

<u>Campanion</u>, is an application that allows you to upload forms, see photos of your camper, send emails and much more. If you haven't already, you can <u>download the Campanion app here.</u>

We'll be sharing photos all summer long, and Campanion's facial recognition technology searches for campers and tags them for you to view in the app.

To get started, follow these steps:

- 1. Download the **Campanion app.**
- 2. Use your **CampInTouch Accoun**t (where you registered your camper) email address and password to log in.
- 3. Complete forms online and upload completed paperwork right in the app.
- 4. Upload a training photo of your child, which enables the app to send you photos of your camper over the summer.
- 5. Ensure you have push notification enabled within your phone settings so you can receive important updates from camp all year long!
